





















STATE PILOT


Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILOT)

- Has decreased since 2010

2018 assessed value of all exempt parcels:


\$7.7 billion

2018 assessed value of state-owned exempt parcels:

\$3.3 billion

Assuming taxation at full value and 100% collection...

Over \$40 million from state property alone



LOCAL COMPOSITE INDEX

The local composite index determines a locality's ability to contribute to the overall costs of education. The following indicators comprise the LCI:

- -True value of real property
- -Adjusted gross income
- -Taxable retail sales
- -Average daily membership

The index ranges from 0 to >1.0, but it is capped at 0.8 to ensure that all divisions receive at least 20% of funding from the state

LCI & RICHMOND

Richmond is uniquely disadvantaged by the LCI

- Real value of property is high compared to other localities
- Use value of property, especially of highest-value property, is low compared to other localities
- Affluent residents skew our adjusted gross income as well as our average daily membership
- Facilities are older and less maintained, due to Massive Resistance and its after effects
- Poverty and other student-based indicators are more concentrated

LCI & RICHMOND

Real vs. Use Value of Property

Total taxable parcels: 70,343

Total exempt parcels: 3,901

~ 6% of all parcels in the City are exempt from taxation
